The Hunger Prevention Partnership of Portage County (HPPP-PC) is offering a limited number of grants (\$8,000 total available) to fund activities that prevent or reduce hunger.

Grants are available as a result of our annual Empty Bowls Collection/Event. These funds are used to develop and sustain programs that both prevent hunger, poverty, and increase food security.

Prevention: For activities that help prevent hunger/poverty, such as:

- Increasing awareness of local hunger/poverty issues such as: community campaigns, media, or other projects
- ✓ Educating children about hunger/poverty
- Collaboratively addressing hunger/poverty
- ✓ Expand current efforts to increase the impact on hunger/poverty

Supplemental Food Assistance: To assist organizations in meeting food assistance needs in Portage County.

HPPP-PC must receive all grant applications no later than November 16, 2021. Incomplete or late proposals will not be considered.

Approval of the grants will be done December 3, 2021. Notifications will follow. Grant dollars will be distributed by the end of calendar year 2021.

A final report to share the outcome or update of your activity/project is required at the large group quarterly meeting of HPPP-PC on August 3, 2022.
